

- 5. A U-shaped clasp used to attach the halyard
- 7. The vertical pole that supports the mainsail

- 11. To turn a sailboat downwind
- 12. A fitting to which lines are secured
- 13. A vertical board at the stern used for steering
- 14. A pole supporting the bottom of the mainsail
- 16. A triangular foresail in front of the mainsail
